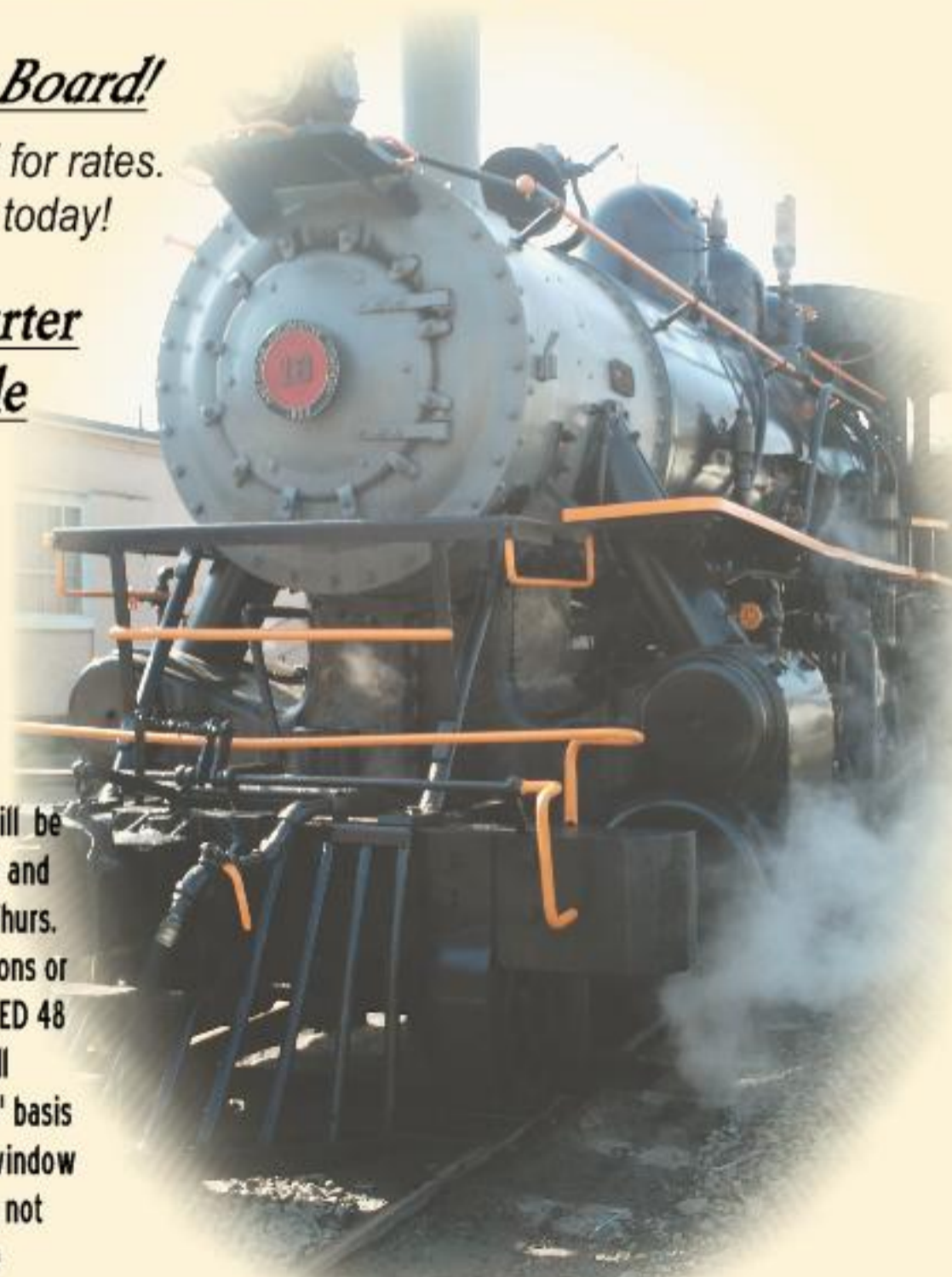

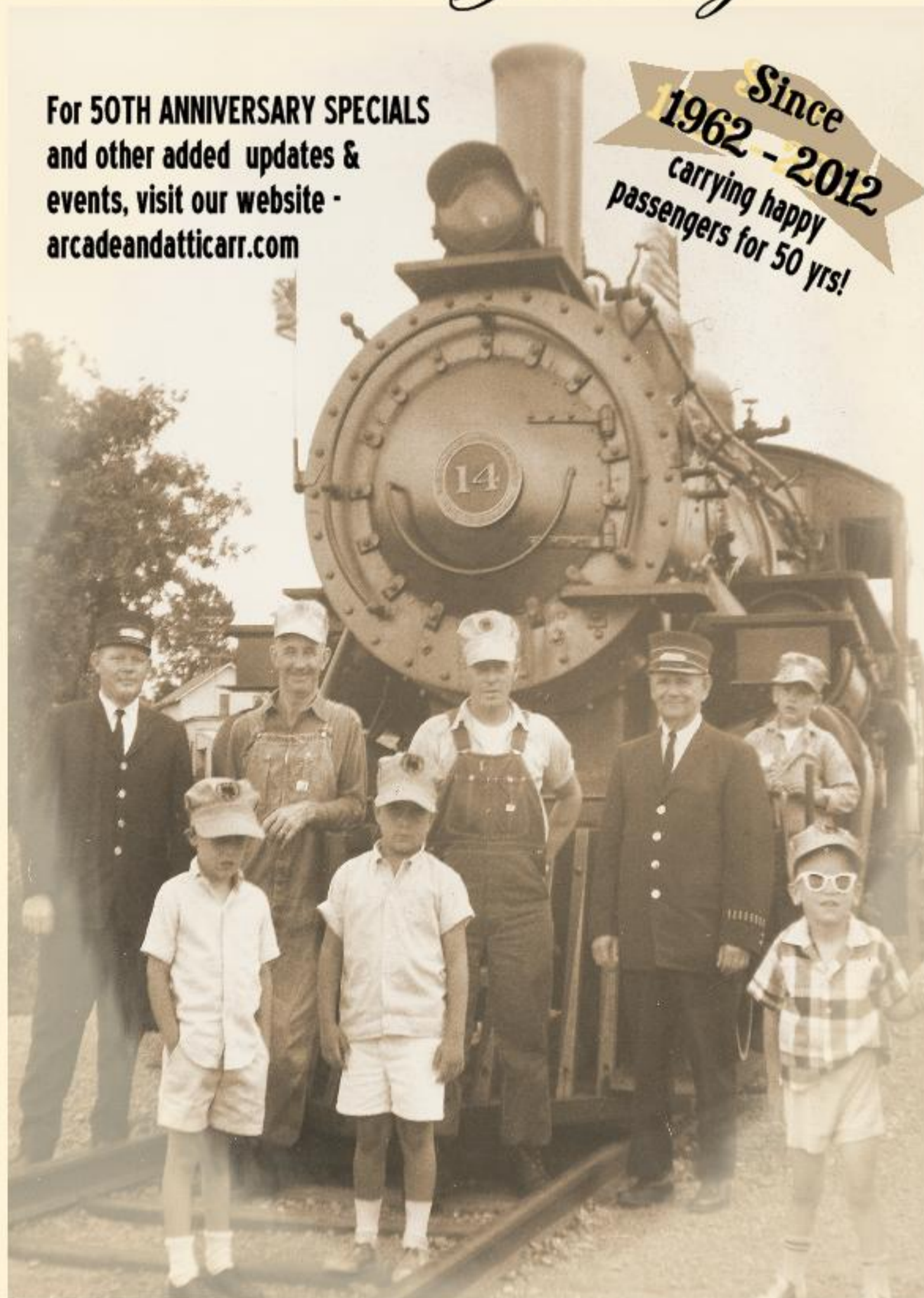

Your journey aboard the Arcade & Attica begins even before you board the train. Incorporated in 1917 the A & A still operates out of its' old historical station on Main St., Arcade, N.Y. Exhibits and photographs on display depict an era of days gone by. The 2 hour trip will be behind either of our vintage World War II diesels Nos. 111 & 112, or the pride of the A & A, No. 18 a 1920's 2-8-0 ALCO steam engine.

Relax aboard our circa 1920 coaches, returned to their original stately splendor, which will transport you to Curriers, much as they did passengers in the early 1900's. Along the way you will see some random appearances of today, but for the most part the trip is through picturesque countryside and farmlands, that have remained virtually unchanged since the line was laid in the 1880's! Splendid beauty abounds for all seasons. At the mid-point of your journey you will have a 15 minute layover at the Curriers Station, while the crew readies the train for the trip back to Arcade. Tour the small historic depot, built in the 1800's, whose offerings are always changing. Visit with the knowledgeable crew of the locomotive, who are always eager to answer questions.

Upon your return to Arcade, take a chance to look around town, visit our great downtown shops and enjoy some lunch. The village park is nearby and is a great place to picnic.

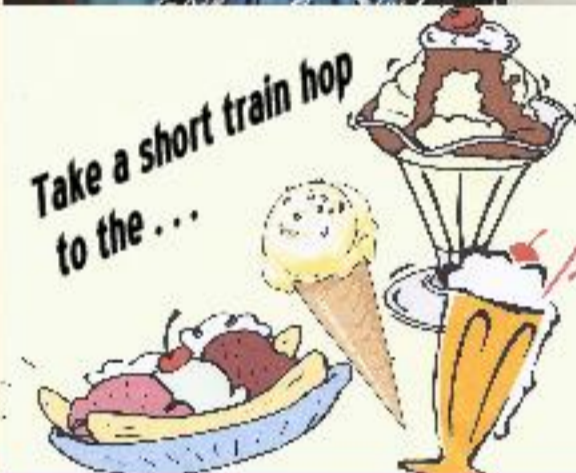


Memorial Day Remembrance
